More than **81,000** students in Wisconsin attend a private school on a voucher or a public charter school.

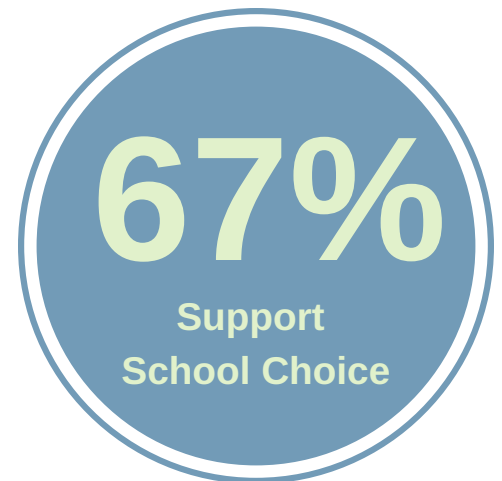


Students attending charter schools or private schools on a voucher receive, on average, **\$2,200 less per pupil** than their public school peers.

- ✓ School choice pushes low-performing schools out of sector.
